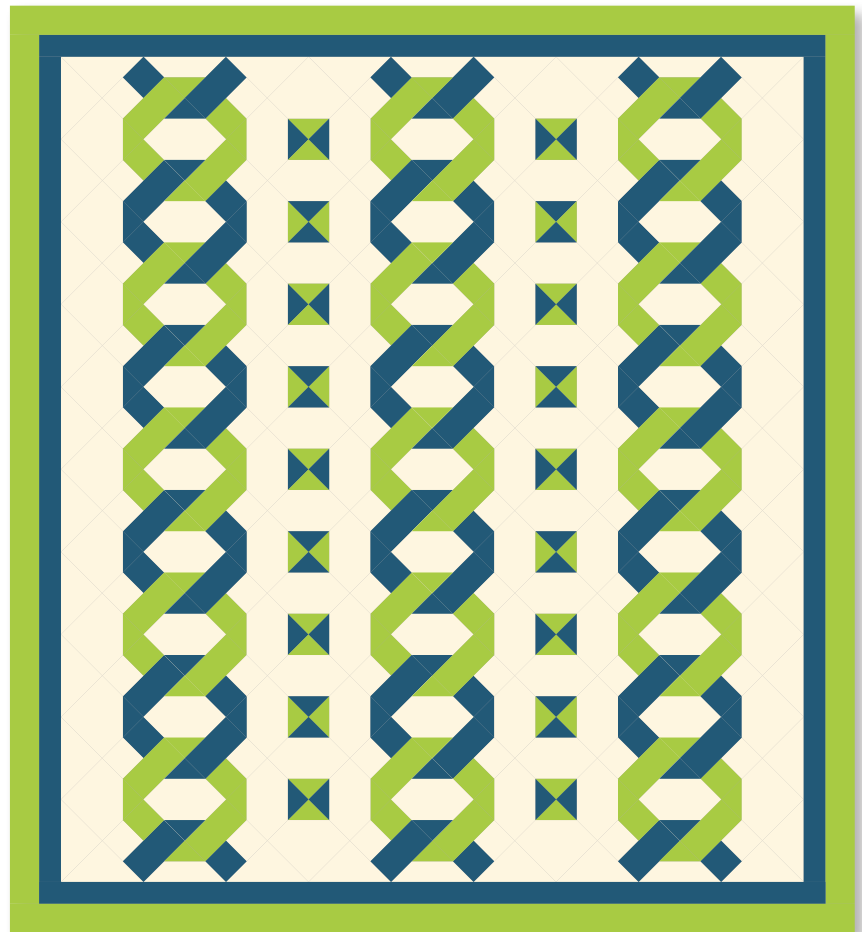
Finished Blocks  
 4 Block Z 8" x 8"  
 10 Block Y 8" x 8"  
 7 Block X 8" x 8"  
 2 Block W 8" x 8"  
 8 Block V 8" x 8"  
 5 Block U 8" x 8"  
 7 Block T 8" x 8"  
 3 Block S 8" x 8"  
 3 Block R 8" x 8"  
 4 Block Q 8" x 8"

## Planning

Inspired by Jane's quilt, *Nexus* in the July/August 2017 issue of *McCall's Quilting*, we envisioned this smaller version. Refer to that issue for instructions to make the blocks for this throw-size quilt. This beautiful design is proof that you only need three fabrics to make a stunning quilt.

Jane's complex design comes together when joining the different blocks. The blocks are easy to make but you will need to use care when joining them, as their placement and orientation are vital to the final woven look of the quilt. We recommend using a design wall.

Use an accurate ¼" seam allowance throughout to ensure all elements of the quilt fit together well.



## Fabric Requirements

- Black print  
1¾ yds. for blocks and 1st border
- Green print  
1⅜ yds. for blocks and 2nd border
- Cream texture  
2½ yds. for blocks
- Backing  
3⅞ yds.
- Batting  
64" x 70"
